- Feedback teachers will continue to provide regular constructive feedback.

 These may be in the form of questions or comments. Questions to be given in a timely manner, which the children should respond to.
- Remote learning will be delivered to the same timetable as in school learning to ensure children attending school on a part time basis can maintain continuity of learning.
- All work posted is seen, most work will receive a comment, some work will be marked in detail.
- Additional pastoral support is available in partnership with JustBe.
