



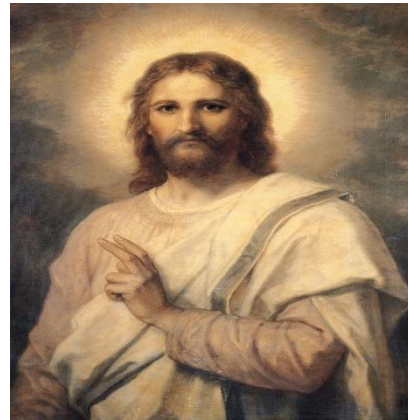
RE - Why Christians believe Jesus was resurrected

Key Vocabulary

Messiah	The promised deliverer of the Jewish nation prophesied in the Hebrew Bible. Jesus is regarded by Christians as the Messiah of the Hebrew prophecies and the saviour humankind.
Prince of Peace	A title given to Jesus Christ.
Saviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A person who saves someone from danger or difficulty.• In Christianity God or Jesus Christ as the redeemer of sin and saver of souls.
Resurrection	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rising again especially from the dead.• The Resurrection: the coming back to life of Jesus Christ three days after he had been killed.
Redeem/ Redeemer	To buy or pay off/To reinstate oneself in someone's good opinion. A person who redeems someone or something.
Servant	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A person employed by another, to perform domestic duties or as a personal attendant.

- There is a strong connection between Christmas and Easter and the concepts of incarnation and salvation.
- Christians believe that the death and resurrection of Jesus restored the relationship between God and people.
