Online Safety Parental Controls

We have updated our Parent Online Safety Controls booklet, which includes an overview of key parental controls.

This guide will help families set up parental controls to provide children with a safer online environment. Parental controls can help to protect your child from seeing something that they shouldn't - although it is important to emphasise that no system is effective all of the time so it is important to engage with your child and talk to them about their online life regularly.

The updated guide contains useful information on; different operating systems home internet consoles, social media TV/Streaming, search engines and mobile devices.

Heat /Sun Safety

As I am sure you are aware the warm weather is set to continue over the weekend and into the start of next week.



There is further advice viable via these two trusted sources.




School Site Security - Update


They all shone with polished professional performances. A huge well done to them all and a big thank you to the team at Harrogate Theatre for helping the children to shine.














Collective Worship Spotlight

Through their charitable foundation they provide a number of subsidised and funded places at their holiday camps. If you would like any further information with regard to this please do speak to Mr Griffiths.


