What time will children start and finish school?

All children will start school at 8.45am and finish at 3.15pm. The gates open at 8.35am so that parents will be able to come onto site, within the 10-minute window. Staff will at their lines by 8.40. Please do not leave children until staff are present. At the end of the day, parents will be able to come onto site from 3.10pm to collect their child. We respectfully ask that parents supervise their child or children until the teacher is present and that children do not play on the play equipment before school starts.



What do the children wear?



What are the dates for the "Meet the Teacher Meetings"?

We feel that it is important for all parents to be able to meet their child's teacher and find out a bit more about the learning and expectations for each year group. There will be chance to do this over the coming weeks. Dates will follow via our usual Friday newsletter.

When do I start to pay for school lunches?

All children from EYFS to Year 2 are entitled to a free school lunch. When a child starts in Year 3, all school dinners need to be paid for. You may find that you meet the criteria for free school lunches and additional details are sent out each term, as there are additional benefits that often people are unaware of.

Packed Lunches

While there is no set list of acceptable or 'banned' items in packed lunches we would for obvious reasons encourage all packed lunches to contain a healthy balance for children.

<u>NHS Change for Life</u> has many fabulous ideas for healthy balanced packed lunches which parents may find helpful.

Snack Trolley & Snacks from Home

While many if not all of us enjoy an occasional sweet treat, it is important we model good healthy balances to our children. With this in mind and having talked to children, staff and our catering team the following changes will be implemented from after October half term.

Our daily snack trolley will contain;

Monday - Thursday. Whole pieces of fresh fruit e.g. apples, bananas, fresh fruit pots/fruit kebabs, raisins, breadsticks, vegetable sticks, milk. Friday (Treat Friday) - As per Monday-Thursday but also fruit juice, milkshake and one sweeter treat such as flapjack/blueberry muffin. We respectfully ask that snacks from home mirror what is available in school. Children in Early Years and Key Stage One will continue to receive free school fruit.
