Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers (Football Association)

Every week millions of children play football, many of them in organised clubs and organisations. As part of its safeguarding response, the Football Association has created a safeguarding course for parents. The course is designed to help parents make

informed choices about the football settings where they enrol their children. The course helps parents recognise best practice and see where there may be concerns, so that they can report them quickly and effectively. This free course can be found here.

Sleep Support for Families

We are pleased to share information regarding a free resource that can help parents and children to learn more about their sleep and develop better bedtime routines. Sleep is essential to brain function, by helping children to sleep better, we can help them to succeed in school.

The free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND. We can talk to young people directly, or parents (we can also talk to adults, including older people, about their sleep issues).

The helpline is open 5 times a week, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday evenings 7-9pm, and Wednesday mornings 9-11am. The number is 03303 530 541.








Year 4 Multiplication Check


PAN Consultation Updated

As per our recent communications with you, we have consulted on a proposed change to our Published Admissions Number (PAN) from September 2024. The consultation ran for six weeks and ended on 14 November. Thank you to everyone who responded.

In total, the consultation received 19 responses. Of these, 11 gave their active support, six raised no objections, one raised some questions, and one raised some questions and some objections. All questions raised are reflected in our FAQ document which can be accessed here.

At a meeting of the Local Governing Body following the end of the consultation period, all the responses received were carefully examined and discussed in detail. As a result, governors have concluded that based on all the information available, and having







studied the overall responses, it is in the best interests of the strategic direction of our school to request that trustees consider changing our PAN from 41 to 30, starting in September 2024. This request has now been made to our trustees who will meet later this month. We will keep families updated following this meeting.


The parent survey can be accessed <u>here</u> and will be open for the next three weeks. We would be most grateful if parents can take a few minutes to respond. Thank you.
