## Safeguarding, Welfare & Wellbeing

Safeguarding and Welfare will always be our very highest priority in helping us achieve our vision of <u>Love Learn Shine</u>. We will use this section of the newsletter each week to keep families up to date with a range of key safeguarding and welfare information.

#### Flu Immunisation

We recognise child immunisation is a matter for parental choice.

Schools are expected to work with health professionals to support the delivery of some childhood immunisation programmes such as flu immunisation. We have already circulated information and registration forms for this year's programme.

We would like to reassure families there is no evidence that healthy unvaccinated people can catch flu from the nasal flu spray and it is safe for children not having the immunisation to be in school on the day immunisations are given. There is further information available via these links.

#### **Bonfire and Firework Safety**

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## **Curriculum Spotlight**

### **Reading Records / Partnership Books**

This year each child will have a reading record rather than a Partnership Book. This can be used to make short notes each time a child reads. Older children are encouraged to begin contributing to and making their own notes and records.

Much of the information previously included in the Partnership Books can be accessed in the various class and curriculum pages of the school website.
