Safeguarding, Welfare & Wellbeing

Safeguarding and Welfare will always be our very highest priority in helping us achieve our vision of <u>Love Learn Shine</u>. We will use this section of the newsletter each week to keep families up to date with a range of key safeguarding and welfare information.

Safeguarding Review

As part of our ongoing commitment to doing the very best we can for all children and families we were pleased to welcome Navigate NDC into school this week. They conducted a safeguarding review following on from the one completed last school year. As well as speaking to the <u>DSL team</u>, scrutinising training records and recruitment files they also spoke to children and reviewed record keeping of safeguarding case work. We will share their conclusions once we have received their report.

NSPCC WhatsApp Support

WhatsApp is one of the most popular instant messaging apps, used by over 2 billion people in 180 countries.

It allows users to send and receive messages, as well as make voice and video calls. Users can connect with people individually or join group chats where lots of people can contribute. <u>NSPCC advice</u> can help families get to grips with the safety tools available.

BeReal App

BeReal is a popular image-sharing app where users can post pictures as well as view other peoples. Users can only post once a day and are only able to see their friends' images if they have shared their own.

At a different time every day, users receive an alert telling them it's 'Time to BeReal'. This gives them two minutes to take a picture, using both the front and back camera of their device and post it on the app. Users may not be familiar with how safe this app is. The <u>NSPCC advice</u> page looks at potential risks, plus top tips for staying safe.


TALK Checklist
