I will take pride in all I do and always do my best.


RESPECTFUL

RECOGNISING		3. Written recognition from the Headteacher. Certificates awarded for key 'Merit Milestones'. 50, 100, 150, 200 and 250.
		2. Written recognition from an adult. 'Positive Merits' awarded via Arbor.
		1. Verbal recognition from an adult.

REMINDING		1. 'Change Needed' verbal reminder. Conversation with the class teacher. Children may be moved within their classroom if considered appropriate.
		2. 'Change Needed' recorded. 'Change Needed' recorded on Arbor. Restorative conversation in child's playtime or lunchtime.
		3. 'Behaviour Incident' or repeated 'Change Needed' recorded. 'Behaviour Incidents' will be recorded on Arbor, communicated to parents and appropriate consequences considered and applied. Repeated and frequent 'Change Needed' incidents will be communicated to parents and appropriate consequences considered and applied.
