Focus - Phonemes s / a / t / p

Pronunciation Phrase - s
Show your teeth and let the s hiss out sssss
Formation Phrase - s
Down the snakes from head to tail.



Pronunciation Phrase - a
Open your mouth wide and make the a sound at the back of your mouth a a a
Formation Phrase - a
Around the astronaut's head and down into space.



Pronunciation Phrase - t
Open your lips; put the tip of your tongue behind your teeth and press t t t
Formation Phrase - t
Down the tiger and across its neck.



Pronunciation Phrase - p
Bring your lips together, push them open and say p p p
Formation Phrase - p
Down the penguin's back, up and around its head.

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



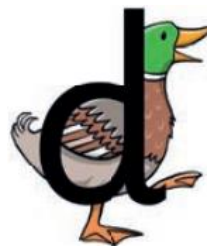
Pronunciation Phrase - i
Pull your lips back and make the i sound at the back of your mouth i i i
Formation Phrase - i
Down the iguana and dot the leaf.



Pronunciation Phrase - n
Open your lips a bit, put your tongue behind your teeth and make the nnnnn sound nnnnn
Formation Phrase - n
Down, up and over the net.



Pronunciation Phrase - m
Put your lips together and make the mmmmm sound mmmmm
Formation Phrase - m
Down, up and over the mouse's ears.



Pronunciation Phrase - d
Put your tongue to the top and front of your mouth and make a quick d sound d d d
Formation Phrase - d
Round the duck's body, up to its head and down to its feet.

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - g

Give me a big smile that shows your teeth. Press the middle of your tongue to the top and back of your mouth; push your tongue down and forward to make the sound g g g

Formation Phase - g

Round the goat's face and curl under its chin.



Pronunciation Phrase - o

Make your mouth into a round shape and say o o o

Formation Phase - o

All around the octopus.



Pronunciation Phrase - c

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say c c c

Formation Phase - c

Curl around the cat.



Pronunciation Phrase - k

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say k k k

Formation Phase - k

Down the kite, up to the top corner and down to the bottom corner.

d - o - g

c - a - t

Pronunciation Phrase - ck
Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say c c c
Catch Phrase - Rock that sock!



Pronunciation Phrase - e
Open your mouth wide and say e e e
Formation Phrase - e
Around the elephant's eye and curl down its trunk.



Pronunciation Phrase - u
Open your mouth wide and say u u u
Formation Phrase - u
Down and around the umbrella and back to the ground



Pronunciation Phrase - r
Show me your teeth to make a rrrrr sound rrrrr
Formation Phrase - r -
From the cloud to the ground and over the rainbow.

Pronunciation Phrase - h
Open your mouth and breath out sharply h h h
Formation Phrase - h
Down, up and over the helicopter.



Pronunciation Phrase - b
Put your lips together and say b as you open them b b b
Formation Phrase - b
Down bears back, up and around it's tummy.



Pronunciation Phrase - f
Open your lips a little; put your teeth on your bottom lip and push the air out to make the sound fffff fffff
Formation Phrase - f
Down the flamingo to its foot and across its wings.



Pronunciation Phrase - l
Open your mouth a little, put your tongue to the top of your mouth behind your teeth and press lllll
Formation Phrase - l
Down, the lollipop stick.
