Leadership Staffing Update

As you will be aware from previous letters Miss Fishburn our Deputy Headteacher and Eagles class teacher has been successful in securing the position of Headteacher at Westbrook Lane Primary school in Leeds from September 2024. After an in-depth review and careful consideration of options, trust and school leaders including governors decided to recruit two Assistant Headteachers to support the ongoing leadership of St Peter's.

Following a thorough and robust process including detailed written applications, as well as a presentation to governors and an interview I am delighted to inform you that that Mrs Jones and Mrs Crankshaw have been appointed to be Assistant Headteachers from September 2024. All elements of their applications and interviews were incredibly strong showing an in-depth knowledge of the school as well as their commitment to St Peter's School. I am sure you will join me in sending our congratulations to them both.


Upper Key Stage Two Poetry


Children in Ravens and Eagles having been writing poetry based on opposing abstract nouns.

They are pleased to share some examples of their writing with you.










Curriculum Overviews

Junior Parkrun Take Over

On Sunday 12th May, St Peters' are doing a take-over of Harrogate Junior Park Run. We would love to see as many students as possible come to take part in the run or help volunteer.

The junior parkrun is a free, weekly, fun, and friendly 2km event for young people between the ages of 4 and 14. The Harrogate run is a 2-lap course round Valley Gardens.

Starting point - The Magnesia Well Café, The Valley Gardens, Harrogate, HG1 2SZ.

Parkrun organise a warmup before the run at c.8:50. Then run will start at 9am and lasts for approximately 10-20 minutes, depending on your pace.

There will be adult marshals all around the course and a tail walker (so that no one will finish last).

Whatever the pace, your child can run or walk the course. You can run or walk the course with your child - if you can keep up!

We would love everyone to get sponsored for taking part in the run, to raise money for school. Sponsor forms will come out in school bags, or we have a JustGiving page for donations:

To get a tracked time from parkrun, you will need to register your child beforehand which is a simple online form to complete. This will allow them to take part and provide you with an email or text with their run time.
