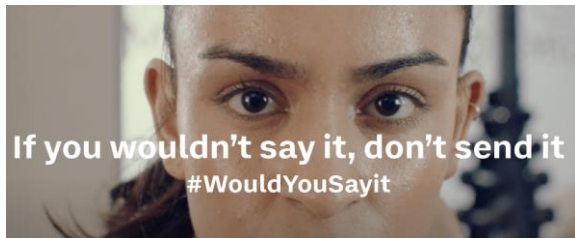

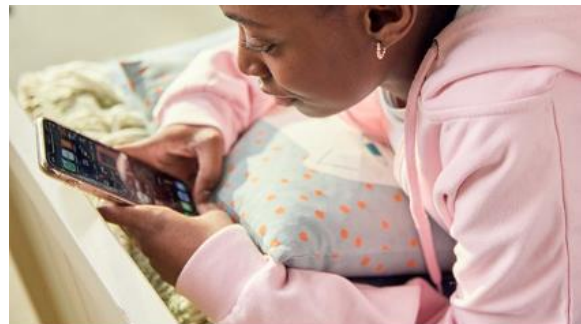
Online Wellbeing and Supervision

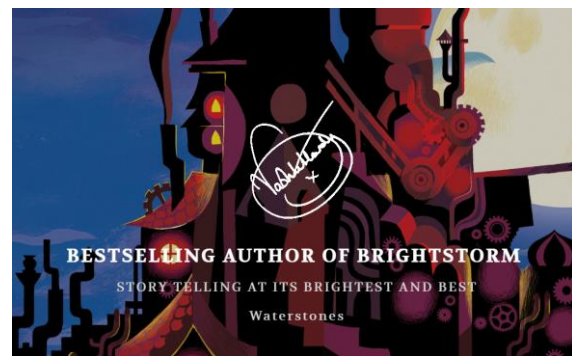
Curriculum & Extra-Curricular Spotlight
