Dear Parents / Carers

RE: Whole School Pantomime - Friday 12th December

Following many successful trips to see the pantomime at Harrogate Theatre, we have made a booking for this year's show, Jack and the Beanstalk on Friday 12th December.

This will be a fabulous opportunity for the whole school to share together in an early start to the Christmas season. The trip takes place during the school day; leaving school at around 11.30am and returning by the end of the school day.

We will be having an early Packed lunch in school before we leave. There will be no hot meals provided by school that day. Parents can either provide their child with a packed lunch or you can order a packed lunch on Select. The school packed lunch will consist of a sandwich, veggie sticks, a slice of cake, a piece of fruit and a jelly or yoghurt pot. Please order a packed lunch on Select by 5pm on Wednesday 5th December, the system will not allow further bookings after that time. We will assume that if no packed lunch has been selected on Select by 5th December, your child will be coming in with a packed lunch.

Children may bring a treat to enjoy at the interval and we request that you provide enough only for your child. We also ask that no nuts or food containing nuts are sent to school.

In previous years this trip has been fully funded by Friends Of St Peters (FOSP), for which we are very grateful. Some parents have suggested they would be happy to contribute directly to the cost of the pantomime visit. Having listened to parents' suggestions, we have decided this year to give parents the option of making a voluntary contribution to the cost of the ticket for their child, which is £13.50. This voluntary contribution can be made on Arbor under Trips. Parents can choose to make a single payment of £13.50, a single payment of any amount up to £13.50, or a single overpayment too as some parents have also suggested they'd be happy to pay for more than one child. Please note, Arbor will **not** allow you to pay in instalments, so once you've paid once you will not be able to make a second payment.



We are extremely grateful to FOSP for their tireless fundraising efforts, and by inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the Pantomime, we can ensure that their hard-earned funds go even further to benefit all our children.

We are asking for parents to accompany us to walk to and from the theatre. If you are able to help please email the school office. We do not require specific consent for this trip as it is covered by the local trips general consent.
