Dear Parents and Carers,

We are committed to making family life and the morning and afternoon routines as easy and simple as possible for everyone. It is wonderful to see so many of our children walking and cycling to school each day. We fully appreciate that this is not possible for everyone, and we are glad to help where this is the case. To support families, we are pleased to provide parking permits for families with children at St Peter's, and we are very happy to offer a permit to anyone who needs one including parents, grandparents and anyone else collecting a child from school. They can be collected from the school office.

We would like to take this opportunity to politely remind families how important it is that these permits are used responsibly so that we can maintain good relationships with our neighbours and those using the roads and pavements around school and to ensure the parking authorities continue to allow this approach to be used.

Recently, Radfield Home Care on Tower Street contacted us because a car displaying a permit was parked in a way that prevented their staff from accessing their property. We have also noticed an increase in cars stopping or parking on double yellow lines. To keep everyone safe and to remain considerate neighbours, please can we remind all families that:

Parking permits only provide a waiver from paying in the nearby pay-and-display bays for a short period while dropping off or collecting children.

- The permits do not allow parking on double yellow lines and will not prevent a parking ticket being issued.
- The permits do not permit blocking driveways, entrances or access to any neighbouring properties, including Radfield Home Care.
- Please always park legally, safely and considerately, even during busy moments.

Please help us maintain a positive relationship with our community and ensure this scheme, which is beneficial to many families, can continue by respecting the parameters of the permit.
