Daily Timings – A Quick Reminder

- **Start of day:** 8.45am children should be in their lines and ready to enter school (staff available from 8.40am). Children in Wren's class enter via their door and do not need to line up.
- **End of day:** 3.15pm

Please note it is not possible to supervise the fixed playground equipment before and after school and as such children should not use the equipment at these times. Thank you.

Entering School & Punctuality

We politely request and remind families that they should always aim for children to be in their class line for 8.45 ready to enter school with their class. Children should only enter via the main reception entrance door if this is their usual route (Herons, Eagles & Ravens) or if the side gates are closed and locked and children can not gain access to the side of school or back playground.

Attendance

Good attendance is vital, and we appreciate your support in helping us keep attendance high. At St Peter's, we know that every day in school makes a difference. Good attendance is key to helping children make the most of their learning, build friendships, and grow in confidence. Each day brings new opportunities to *Love, Learn, Shine* and we want every child to experience them all.

These appointments are an important opportunity to discuss your child's progress and next steps for learning. Winter Weather Clothing & School Closure Contingencies

As I am sure you are aware we have been experiencing some freezing temperatures in recent days and weeks. Although we are at the start of the Spring term the weather is still very wintry. Please ensure children have a named warm coat, and as needed, hats and gloves. Whenever it is safe, break and lunchtimes will be outside, so coats should be in school every day and clearly labelled. Outdoor play and learning continue throughout the colder months, and a warm coat helps ensure your child stays comfortable and healthy while enjoying their time outside.

While rare, extreme weather or unforeseen events may require early closing, delayed opening, or full closure. We will always prioritise safety and keep families informed via Arbor messages, email, and the News Section of our website. If no message is issued, school will operate as normal. Swimming

School Stationery

As was the case last term school will provide all the necessary stationery items for children to use in school. Children should not bring any stationery items from home into school. Any items brought in will be kept safe and returned to the child or parent at the end of the day.

Snacks from home

While many, if not all of us enjoy an occasional sweet treat, it is important that we model a good, healthy balance to our children. We request that any snack sent for morning break is a piece of fruit, bread sticks or crackers or a similar healthy option.

Nut Aware

We are a Nut Aware School. This means where it is within our control for example the meals school provides there are no nuts or nut products used. We politely ask that children bringing in snacks and or packed lunches do not bring any nuts or seeds including hummus including any products that may contain nuts. We thank families for their support with this.
