The Climate Crew are excited to introduce our Climate Education reading spine; designed to inspire curiosity, spark conversation and nurture climate-conscious learners. The Climate Education reading spine is a collection of eco-themed books you will read during your time at St Peter's.

Each term, our dedicated **Climate Crew** will deliver a carefully selected **climate-themed book** to every class in a distinctive **green drawstring bag**. These books have been chosen to help you explore nature, sustainability, and our changing world through powerful stories and engaging illustrations.

## **How It Works — Step by Step**

### **1. Delivery**

At the start of each term, the Climate Crew will visit every classroom to deliver **one climate-themed book inside a labelled green drawstring bag**.

### **2. Explore the Story**

The class teacher chooses a time during the term that best fits their timetable to share the book with the class. This could be during whole-class reading, story time, circle time or linked to a relevant curriculum topic.

### **3. Keep Everything Together**

Whenever the book is not in use, **it should be stored safely inside the green bag**. This ensures the book is protected and easy to collect at the end of term.

### **4. End-of-Term Collection**

In the final week of term, the Climate Crew will return to each class to **collect the green bags and the books inside**.

### **5. A Fresh Start Each Term**














At the beginning of the next term, a new book in a new green bag will be delivered—building a rich reading spine across the year and across the school.
