Attendance Matters- Update & News

Attendance Matters – Authorised and Unauthorised Explained

We regularly review attendance and want to clarify the difference between authorised and unauthorised absence. Unauthorised absence does not prevent parents from exercising their own beliefs or making family choices. It simply means the reasons given do not meet the limited criteria schools must follow. Schools are expected by the Department for Education and Ofsted to maintain high attendance, and this is closely considered during inspections. We always aim to be consistent and fair in our decisions. We are happy to talk with families about any concerns and will always support children when they return to school. However, we ask parents to understand that there are very few circumstances that qualify as exceptional for authorised absence.
